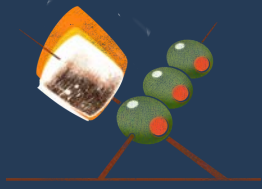

On **October 17th**, we welcomed our community of supporters to our annual event for the first time in Downtown Chicago and raised **\$132,000** to send even more kids to camp!



2024 WAS A YEAR OF GROWTH ACROSS CAMP FOR ALL KIDS

- **The Campership Program and Four Star Fellowship achieved growth in participant numbers** - Campership had a 15% increase and Four Star Fellowship had 43% increase over 2023. We served 338 youth this summer through both programs, more than ever before!
- **Collaboration with camp, school, and community partners to develop and support a camp-going culture across the families we serve** - Campership and Four Star Fellowship Steering Committees and partners work with CFAK staff to participate in recruitment events and touchpoints to reinforce our camp community year-round and increase the number of youth we serve.
- **Engage the community we serve and our partners to support success for campers and families** - CFAK Camp Connectors is a mentoring program pairing existing CFAK families with prospective/new families to provide support. In April 2025, we will host our first Campership Kickoff event bringing together CFAK families, camp directors and staff, and school partners to gear up for a great summer!
- **Increased and diversified funding sources** - CFAK was honored to received the Invest for Kids grant this year, as well as being chosen for the American Camp Association Leadership Pathways grant, a three-year cohort supporting increased pathways to leadership in camping for underrepresented youth.
- **Staff growth in line with our 2024-2026 Strategy** - Camp for All Kids has increased from 1.5 to 4.5 FTE staff in the past two years to support program growth, increased touchpoints with families and partners, and collaboration with camp and community partners to institutionalize best practices for success.

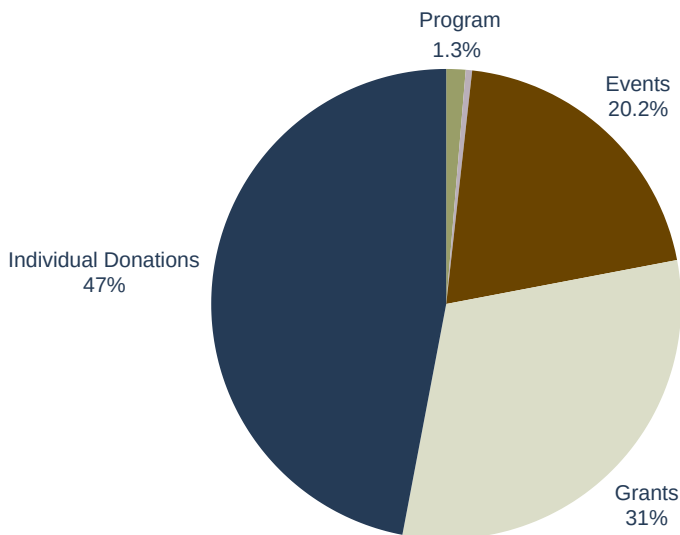
